

Full Cost Recovery, Third Sector Organisations

Historically, third sector organisations have struggled to secure funding for their overhead costs, making themselves and their services unsustainable. Using full cost recovery, organisations can ensure that the contracts and grants they secure reflect the full costs of delivery, including overhead costs.

The course aims to guide participants through the process of full cost recovery and provide a practical toolkit and spreadsheet which should be acceptable by any funder. Topics covered include the benefits of using the FCR model, the different sort of costs to consider, how to rationally divide costs, the ARAF process, cost drivers and how to allocate the costs.
